## Materials

Many of my models are made with funds of wool and do not require a whole skein of the same color, so you can completely build your own color chart with your own funds of wool.

- Size 3/D corchet hook or size needed for the yarn
- Some green Yarn
- Some light blue yarn
- Some dark blue yarn
- Some red yarn
- Fiberfill
- Tapestry needle

## Head

We begin with Head. Stuff regularly.

Chain 2

**Rnd 1** : Ch1, 6 Sc in the second stich from hook, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 2** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 3** : Ch1, [2 Sc in next stich, 1 Sc on the next], join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 4** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 5** : Ch1, [2 Sc on next stich, 1 Sc. on each of the next 3 stich, 2 Sc on the next., 1 Sc on the each of the next 3 stich], join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 6** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 7** : Ch1, [2 Sc on the next stich, 1 Sc on each of the 5 next stich., 2 Sc on the next, 1 Sc on each of the 3 next stich], join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 8** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 9** : idem.

**Rnd 10** : Ch1, [2 Sc on the next stich, 1 Sc on each of the 7 next stich, 2 Sc on the next, 1 Sc on each of the 7 next stich], join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 11** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 12** : Ch1, [Dec., 1 Sc on the 3 next stich, Dec., 1 Sc on the next 3 stich, Dec., 1 Sc on the next stich, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 13** : 1 ml, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

## Body

**Rnd 14 to 83** : As Rnd 13.

## Tail

**Rnd 84** : Ch1, 2 Dec. in the Rnd, Sc on the other stich, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 85** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 86 to 88** : As Rnd 85.

**Rnd 89** : Ch1, 2 Dec. in the Rnd, Sc on the other stich, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 90 & 91** : Ch1, Sc in each Sc, join with slip stitch.

**Rnd 92** : Ch1, Dec. all around. Leaving long end, fasten off.

## Tongue

Chain 5

**Rnd 1** : Sc in the second stich from hook.

**Rnd 2** : Ch2, turn

**Rnd 3** : Sc in the second stich from hook, slip stich where we had done Sc in Rnd.

## Finishing

1. Secure end.
2. Embroider eyes as shown on photo.
3. Sew the tongue.
